# Frequently Asked Questions About Play Matta...

#### What critical fall height (CFH) can Play Matta achieve?

Play Matta offers an unparalleled certified CFH up to 4.5m making it ideal for all items of play equipment. The Play Matta system consists of interlocking recycled PVC tiles, which are installed over a weed barrier membrane and recycled rubber shock pads (these are available in a number of different specifications enabling the CFH to be tailored to each piece of equipment).

### How do you clean Play Matta?

Any build up of dirt can be cleaned off Play Matta surfaces by power washing to a recommended 2000 p.s.i or scrubbing with a stiff broom and bucket of water containing industrial strength floor cleaner.

#### Can you have circular or irregular shaped installations of Play Matta?

Yes! Installed by our team of Matta experts, Play Matta installations can be fitted to almost any shape required, with the edges either ramped into the ground, fitted with ramped edges or fitted flush with surrounding surfaces.

#### Will the colours fade?

Fading is difficult to control in outdoor playgrounds exposed to UV rays. Like the surrounding environment including asphalt, paint, timber, playground equipment and any rubber surfaces - Play Matta will exhibit some fading over time. This is why we recommend our standard colour range for the main part of a design, as these are particularly resistant to fading. The addition of a few tiles from the bright or light colour ranges then work very effectively as accent colours.



There are a number of reasons we encourage customers to use Play Matta light and bright colours as accents rather than for large area coverage...

- Playground equipment is often brightly coloured and is better complemented by the more neutral tones of our standard colour range
- In the outdoor environment, Play Matta standard colours better complement the surroundings, echoing the colours of sky, clouds
- As with all brightly coloured objects, prolonged UV exposure can affect colour intensity, and despite the addition of UV stabilisers, some colour fading may occur over time to the brighter coloured palette

Play Matta is engineered to deliver a consistent safety performance and durability, and this consistency & durability also extends to our colour production standards. Our ISO quality controls, including CIELab (International Colour Standards) colour testing, ensure Play Matta colour standards are maintained as accurately as possible and meet specified

As the product is manufactured from recycled material, some colour differences will naturally occur. However our standards ensure that these are kept to an absolute minimum and will not adversely effect any design or installation. The tolerance levels we work to are tough, but achievable and provide a high level of product consistency and reliability.
